Institut Pendidikan Indonesia provides financial relief for students from low-income backgrounds.

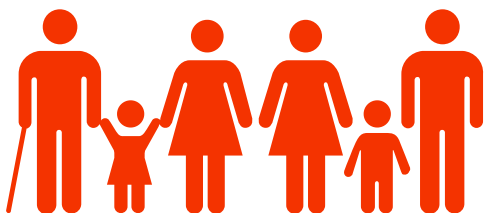
