## IPI Provides Free Internet Access for the Community: Bridging the Digital Divide for Quality Education

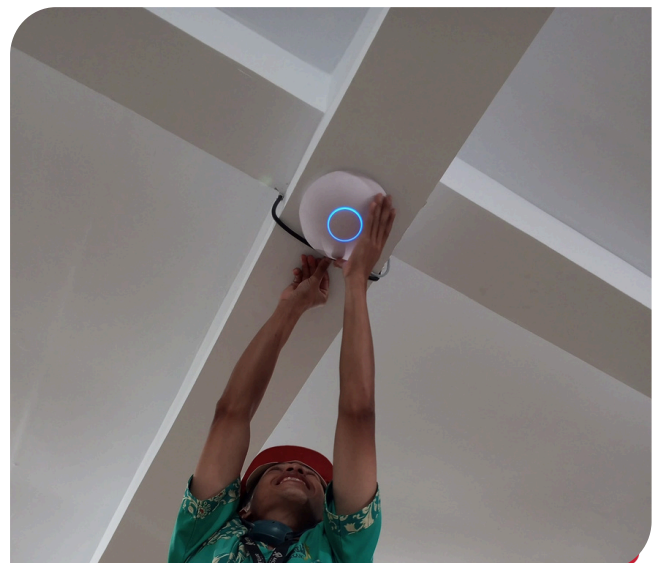


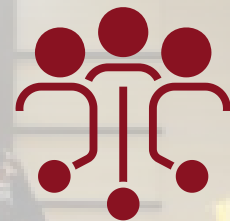

# Revitalizing Literacy Culture through Digital Library Innovation to Enhance Community Welfare in Garut

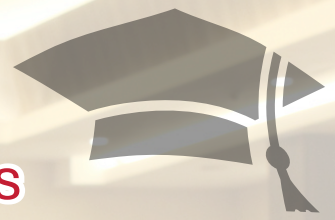
